Kingston Day Care and The Very Busy Summer of 2012...

St. Martha Child Care Centre was a bee-hive of activity this summer. In a nutshell, we 're-located the centre within itself'. The Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board offered us the opportunity to provide the Before and After School programming for the Full Day Kindergarten program and we accepted. New equipment was purchased, staff hired and programming planned. Sarah and Rebecca are doing an awesome job with this new program.

We expanded our Infant Program from 3 spaces to 6 spaces, which also involved the creation of two infant sleep rooms.

The Infant Program was re-located to the opposite side of the child care centre, where access to the kitchen and less traffic through the program, have proven to be real assets for the children and staff. The Toddler and Preschool Programs were re-located as well.

The Family Studies Room in St. Martha School is now a classroom, hence the relocation of our After School Program to the two portables. Prep work occurred throughout July with Carol and Crystal taking a lead as the teachers for this program. We are fortunate to have such staff who are clearly up for the challenges and they have met every expectation.

Many thanks are extended to Mr. Murray, principal of St. Martha School; the Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District Board for the opportunity to extend our program; and the physical plant for all of the support offered. Thank you to all of the contractors, especially Chris Payne, as without his and Dan's support, we truly would not have secured our license to operate. Finally, I offer gratitude to Marcelina and the staff at St. Martha Child Care Centre, as well as the children and their families who have lived through the licensing changes. This was a big project and the success of it was because of many.

Trillium Child Care Centre ~ Toddler's Seasonal Fun!


